



REQUIREMENTS FOR DIVERSITY IN PROGRAMMING AND WORKPLACE

(Ratified by Board of Trustees in April 2005 and re-ratified in August 2023)

1. Dayton Public Radio is listener-oriented, community centered and values teamwork and excellence.
2. Both staff and listeners are valued as individuals and every attempt will be made to reflect this diversity in the workplace and in the programming.
3. The Citizens' Advisory Council will be charged with monitoring diversity in programming on a quarterly basis.
4. The station will adhere to all regulations from both the Federal Communications Commission and the Corporation for Public Broadcasting as they relate to diversity in the workplace.
